Information for library users

How many items can you borrow?

An item could be, for example, a book, a DVD or a magazine. From October to May, you may borrow **20 items.**During the summer (from 1 June to 30 September), you may borrow **30**

During the summer (from 1 June to 30 September), you may borrow **30 items**.

For how long?

You may borrow items **for 28 days**. You may extend the loan **once**.

Where should items be returned?

If you have borrowed items from a City of Lausanne Library,

Please return them:

- directly to one of the libraries
- or to the **return boxes** (outside of opening hours).

How much does it cost?

Registration and borrowing are **free**.
But the library asks you to **follow the conditions of use**.

For example:

- If an item is returned late, you will have to pay a fine.
- If you lose or damage an item, you will have to pay for its repair or replacement. It is for the library to buy the new item.

Information for library users

Can I extend the loan of an item?

Yes, you may extend it once at most. For a further 28 days.

If the item has **not been reserved** by anyone else, you may extend the loan:

- by telephone: 021 315 69 15

- by email: bibliotheques@lausanne.ch

- on our website: bayl.lausanne.ch

- or by using the self-service kiosks in the library.

Is it possible to reserve an item?

Yes, you can reserve an item **that has already been borrowed** by someone else.

There is no charge. To make a reservation, go to the library website: bayl.lausanne.ch

To reserve an item that is **on the shelves**, please ask a member of staff at the desk.

There are over 220,000 items in our libraries.

For adults and children, from birth.

You will find these items:

- available for self-service, on our shelves
- or by reserving them online.

There are:

- novels
- comic books, including manga
- newspapers and magazines
- audiobooks
- DVD and Blu-ray collections

also:

- books in different languages
- information documents in all fields.

What can you do in our libraries?

Work in peace

You will find a quiet place to work and study in the libraries.

It will help you concentrate.

Watch films and surf the internet

In our libraries, you can also:

- watch a DVD
- take a language course
- use a portable multimedia player with an audio headset (To do this, you will need to leave your identity card as a deposit)
- use a double jack connector to watch a film or TV series together with another person
- surf the internet, borrowing a touch screen tablet.

Access to City of Lausanne WiFi is free.

Have you forgotten your headphones?

Don't worry. We will lend you an audio headset.

You are free to use this equipment within our libraries.

Loss or damage

If you lose or damage an item, you must pay the purchase price and additional charges:

Have you lost an item?

Have you already paid the charges?

If you find the item **in good condition**, you may return it to the library within 30 days.

Show the receipt for your payment.

The library will then refund you almost all of it. It will keep CHF 10.00. After 30 days, it will keep CHF 15.00.

Other charges
